NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Amounts shown in the Income Statement are exclusive of goods and services tax.

a) Revenue

Interest Income

Interest income is recognised in the period in which it is received.

Membership Fees

Membership fees are recognised as income in the period to which they relate.

Donations

Donations are recognised as income upon receipt.

b) Taxation

The Society's activities are exempt from income tax pursuant to Section 50.5 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997. However, the Society is subject to and liable for other taxes in accordance with State ans Commonwealth legislation.
